

Since Stage Two statutory consultation on our proposals for Gate Burton Energy Park closed in August 2022, we have made some localised changes to the extent of certain works (the indicative Order Limits) for the project.

These changes relate to minor additions we have made to the boundary for the project – known as indicative Order Limits – which result in a small increase in land take.

The reasons for these additions relate to the engineering and construction of the project. We have also adjusted the indicative Order Limits in a number of places so that they now follow field and land ownership boundaries.

Your views are important to us, we are therefore holding this further stage of consultation to give you the opportunity to comment on the amendments we have made.

We will continue to revise the indicative Order Limits in response to any feedback we receive prior to submitting our application for a Development Consent Order (DCO) to the Planning Inspectorate.


